# CEIP Background

- CEIPs are part of Washington's 2019 Clean Energy Transformation Act (CETA)
- First round of utility CEIPs are due by January 1, 2022
- CEIP outlines CETA goals – and actions needed to meet those goals – over the next four years

## CETA

- No coal by 2026
- Greenhouse gas neutral by 2030
- 100% clean by 2045

# CEIP Background, continued

- CEIP must be informed by the Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) and CETA Clean Energy Action Plan (CEAP)

*IRP: Outlines the sources of power needed to supply District customers through 2030*

*CEAP: Outlines District's 10-year plan for preparing to meet CETA's 2030 and 2045 standards*

# CEIP Content

- Targets for 2022-25:
  - Renewable energy
  - Demand response
  - Energy efficiency
- Specific actions planned for 2022-25 to meet those targets and to prepare for CETA's 2030/2045 standards
- Proposed targets and actions will be presented at the Nov. 15<sup>th</sup> meeting and will align with the draft IRP

# CEIP Content, continued

- Identify Highly Impacted Communities
- Identify Vulnerable Populations
- Select customer benefit indicators

*Utilities must “ensure that all customers are benefiting from the transition to clean energy: Through the equitable distribution of energy and nonenergy benefits and reduction of burdens...”*

– CETA
