Why we're here

No board action required

Resolution 07-13163 delegated authority to General Manager to adjust or introduce new fees and charges without action of the Board



Fees & Charges Recent History

- 2021 Implemented System Impact Fees
- 2022 Paused increases to evaluate impacts of supply chain costs post-COVID
- 2023 Revised cost methodologies and assumptions to balance cost recovery efforts while costs continue to climb
 - Adjustments included ~20% of costs increases
 - Developed improved implementation plan for future adjustments



Electric Service Connection Fees

- Applicable to new or increasing service connections
- Based on average transformer, meter, and labor costs, and system impact fee
- Typical impact to single phase ~\$300 per connection
- Typical impact to three phase ~\$700 per connection

Other Service Charges

- Applicable to new service pole and handhole installations
- Adjustments reflective of increased material and labor costs (~10% increase)

- See appendix for full list of adjustments



Water Meter Fees & Charges

- Applicable to new or increasing domestic water connections
- Includes the average cost of meter and installation labor
- Typical impact ~\$200 per connection for 1 ½" and 2" meter sizes

Customer Service Fees & Charges

- Applicable to account setup for new customers, transfers of service, disconnects and reconnects
- Amounts last updated in 2016
- Most adjustments limited to ~20%

Implementation & Outreach Plan

- Revised Fees & Charges effective January 1, 2025
 - Service connection fees applicable to new or increasing connections
 - Paid fees will be honored through Dec. 2025 unless project scope has changed
- Outreach to include
 - Postcards to builders & contractors
 - Direct mailer to customers with pending applications/projects
 - Engage internal stakeholders
 - Update web content
