Follow-Up Q&A

Can customer-owners still launch boats without a fee?

We anticipate implementing a Pilot Program with State Parks as soon as 2025 that will allow free launching at all District sites managed by State Parks.

Is it possible for customer-owners to have preference for camping reservations?

Technical, logistical and policy challenges prevent this option at present.

Will dump station access be enhanced?

State Parks anticipates expanded dump station access over the current situation under District management.

What it the timeline?

A longer transition period is now anticipated with the District managing the Park through the 2025 recreational season.
