Background summary

- Installation of Electric Vehicle (EV) Chargers was required for building occupancy of Service Center
- 14 Level II chargers are installed in public parking spaces
- Billing and point-of-sale administration will be handled by ChargePoint
- Board requested staff to provide a rate option reflecting full cost

Rate Option 1

- Bill use as Rate Schedule 2 Commercial Rate:
 - Commercial Energy rate: 2.7 ¢/kWh
 - Billing, admin and other: 2.01 ¢/kWh
- 4.71 ¢/kWh

Rationale: Fully recovers rate schedule 2 energy costs. Mirrors costs of other businesses offering same type of service.

Rate Option 2

- Implement a full-cost rate
 - Includes a blend of the production, delivery, and customer costs
- Proposed Rate: 6¢/kWh June

Rationale: Follows the philosophy used to develop rates for customer classes with little to no usage history/data
