

Lease & Operating Agreement

- City of Entiat to provide park and Entiatqua Trail operation and maintenance
 - Camping
 - Turf maintenance
 - Restrooms and garbage
- Initial one-year agreement to give City experience operating expanded and refurbished facilities
- District landscape contractor will attend to plantings and irrigation under one-year warranty of construction contract

Lease & Operating Agreement

- Park revenue first priority to offset City of Entiat's park operating costs
- District agrees to reimburse City for park operating costs that would exceed revenues
 - ➤ Up to \$75K for the one-year term (PUD currently provides \$65K annually)
 - ➤ Ability to cover other documented operating expenses up to, but not exceed, \$100K
- Agreement contemplates negotiating long-term lease (for the term of FERC license) based on experience of first year operations.

Lease & Operating Agreement

- District will loan city of Entiat essential park maintenance equipment for 2015 season
- A portion of Entiat Park construction contingency monies are anticipated to be used in longer-term agreement to purchase new equipment for park operations in 2016
- City of Entiat and the District agree to mutual indemnification and insurance provisions
