 - Out for bid and construction ready

 - Submitted for permit and preparing for bid
- Old Headquarters Building:
 - Decommissioned technology systems
 - Explored conceptual designs for achieving community vision
 - Presented steps for old HQ Building and remaining parcels





Current State – Project Activities

- Electric Avenue:
 - Awarded to Smith Excavation
 - Surface demo and underground tanks removed construction underway
- Fish & Wildlife Building Modifications
 - Awarded to Ridgeline Custom Builders
 - Mobilized abatement and construction crews
- Old Headquarters Building:
 - Pacific Engineering engaged for retaining wall design
 - Surveying facility for hazardous materials and future abatement needs







FUTURE STATE – ELECTRIC AVENUE & ANCHOR USES




