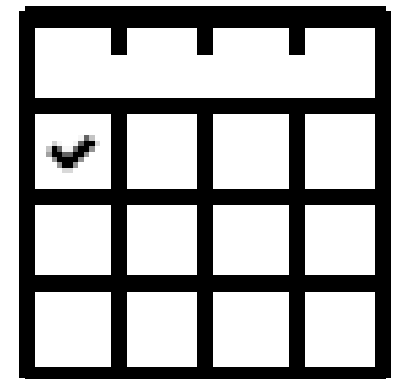

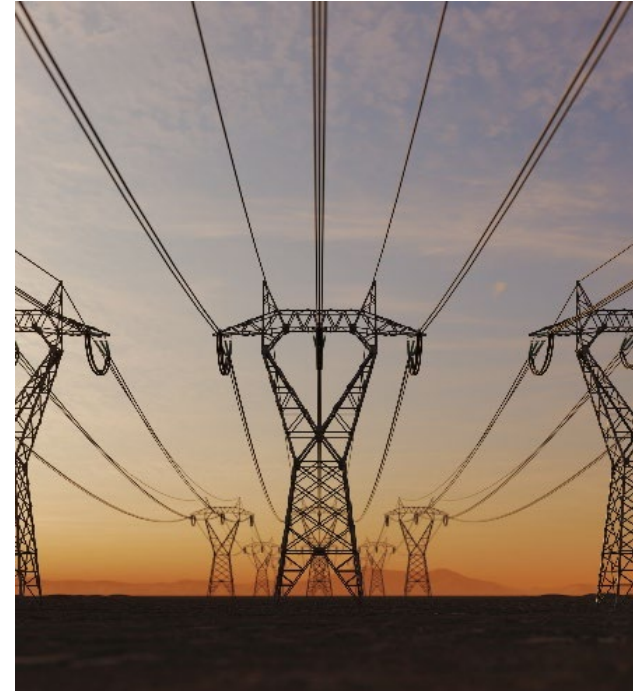
Session Overview

- Day 64 of 105
- **Headlines**
 - Budget season begins
 - Gov. Ferguson supports spending cuts
 - Legislative leaders may seek new revenue
- **Deadlines**
 - April 2 – Opposite house policy committee
 - April 8 – Opposite house fiscal committee
 - April 16 – Opposite house cutoff
 - April 27 – Last day of session (“Sine Die”)
