

OVERLOADING CIRCUITS

- •Use power strips with surge protection but avoid plugging too many high-power devices into one outlet.
- •Know the circuit's load capacity and avoid exceeding it.



EXTENSION CORDS





ONLY USE EXTENSION CORDS RATED FOR THE INTENDED USE (INDOOR/OUTDOOR).

AVOID RUNNING CORDS UNDER CARPETS, RUGS, OR THROUGH DOORWAYS.

GFCI

- •Ensure appliances and tools have a grounded plug (three-prong).
- •Test GFCI (Ground Fault Circuit Interrupter) outlets regularly to ensure they work properly.



CLASS C FIRE EXTINGUISHER

- •Know how to use a Class C fire extinguisher for electrical fires.
- •Never use water to extinguish an electrical fire.
