Individual Recognition

Recognition of individuals, such as family members, will only be permitted upon approval through the designated program.

Individual recognition requests are accepted year-round and placed in the queue for evaluation in February each year. Upon approval Chelan PUD Park staff will assist in coordinating and purchasing your individual recognition request.

The Park Bench Program, which enables a family, or individual to purchase a park bench and dedicate it to a chosen individual. The Chelan PUD offers a standard park bench option available in black. Each bench includes a 10.5" width by 3" height plaque, allowing for up to four lines of text with a maximum of 28 characters/spaces per line to recognize the individual. Any proposed wording for the plaque must receive preapproval from the park manager or their designee. The Chelan PUD will be responsible for ordering the bench and plaque. The Chelan PUD will assess and determine the placement of each proposed bench to ensure that the chosen location aligns with the requirements for current maintenance and operations at each park site.

To maintain aesthetics and prevent overcrowding in our parks, the Chelan PUD will enforce limits on the number of benches permitted at each park location. Benches placed along trailways must be spaced at intervals greater than 1/8 of a mile from each other. Additionally, no more than 20 park benches will be permitted in any single park location.

The recognition program necessitates a fee of \$3000 from the dedicator to support the operation and maintenance of the park. The Chelan PUD will exert every effort to safeguard and maintain any dedicated bench, ensuring it receives the standard care and maintenance. However, in the event of repairs to surrounding areas, park or facility construction, or redesign, the bench may need to be relocated. If damage occurs due to vandalism or natural aging, the Chelan PUD reserves the right to remove or repair the item at its sole discretion.

All other donations and gifts are appreciated and will undergo evaluation by a park committee.
